<b>Muga Blanco, Rioja</b> Barrel fermented Viura with further ageing in oak. White flowers, stone fruits with a touch of vanilla. The oak is not overdone, leaving space for a long, savoury finish	£9	£35	£20
<b>Babylonstoren Viognier, South Africa</b> 70% of this wine underwent fermentation in stainless steel tanks whilst the other 30% was fermented oak barrels before being blended together and bottled.
